Combined Meth Lab Response Training

Harris County Sheriff's Office will be providing TCLEOSE Credits. Registration Form

On October 17-21, 2011 Law Enforcement and Emergency Response Personnel are invited to attend the <u>Combined Meth Lab Response Training</u> in Humble Texas. This is a 40-hour training program hosted by the Harris County Sheriff Department, designed to train Law Enforcement and Emergency Response Personnel to safely and effectively process meth labs. Your curriculum includes all aspects of the OSHA HAZWOPER training and much more. The class is designed for full meth lab response including Site Operations, Processing, Evidence Collection, Pre-Response Briefings, Crime Scene Photography, Chemical Segregation and Personal Protective Equipment choice, use and limitations.

Personnel attending the training will receive all training materials, laminated quick card and a CD. This is a certification program. Certifications include HAZMAT Specialist, On-site Incident Commander and Level A certification.
