SOUTH EAST TEXAS REGIONAL RADIO SYSTEM (SETRRS)

"Jefferson, Hardin, and Orange Counties"

History Brief: Starting in the year 2006 Mid and South Jefferson County received a Port Security Grant to Merge an 800MHz Sharenet Radio System with North Jefferson County's 800MHz Smart net Radio System. Then after that and until 2013 the three separate systems in Jefferson, Hardin, and Orange Counties were merged by using Interoperability Grants and Port Security Grants. Secondly, Jefferson County merged with Hardin County and third, the City of Orange and Orange County merged to create the SETRRS. The system has been upgraded to a P-25 7.X System and is now a fully regionalized radio system.

NOTE: As per the South East Texas Regional Planning Commission, Regional Interoperability Committee meeting held on <u>April 18, 2007</u>, it was discussed and agreed that the SETRRS 800MHz radio system would program the following talk groups on all POLICE, FIRE, EMS/HEALTH, PUBLIC WORKS, & INDUSTRY radios as shown below:
