#### OLD BUSINESS:

IMT Committee Chair, Tim Ocnaschek discussed the research and quotes regarding an IMT deployment uniforms. \$5000 was allocated at the August meeting. Chief Frenzel made a motion to purchase 3 shirts and one pair of pants for each deployable IMT member with an MOU from the Texas Forest Service. Then if allocated funding remained, an additional shirt and pair of pants was eligible for those members most active deploying. Chief Curran seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Secretary/Treasurer Tim Ocnaschek discussed a recommendation made at the recent Board meeting to complete a review of the existing email addresses during the September 2013 Strategic Planning Meeting. A recommendation was made to reduce the email list to include only those members designated as voting, alternate voting, non-voting, authorized representatives, and honorary members. The email system has been traditionally difficult to manage, and this change will assist in keeping the lists more current, streamlined, and valid. If guests or other member organization members need the notification, emails can be forwarded by the noted official member recipients. An additional recommendation was made to update email addresses on a yearly basis based on dues payments received, and only paid members would be left on the active email account. This recommendation received favorable comments from the membership, but not formal vote was conducted.

2. Strategic Planning Committee Chair, Cindy Powers, presented the updates recommended for the Strategic Plan. A motion was made by Anne Huff to accept the Strategic Plan as presented. Stephanie Garsea seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
