SNCA Board:

Cheniere, Sabine Pass Facility, has asked to be allowed to rejoin the Sabine Neches Chiefs' Association. Their membership lapsed in late 2016 and 2017 during some organizational oversight and staffing issues. I met with Craig Corder and Archie Mckeivier on June 20, 2018 and they reaffirmed their leaderships desire to reestablish their relationship with the Sabine Chief's Association and expressed their goal of getting back involved. They do have waterborne fire suppression assets. Since they are technically outside the Association boundaries but directly work with and are impacted by this region, I believe they meet the pre-requisites of a Provisional member, and thus would be eligible as a non-voting member, as they did during their initial membership. I believe they would be a valuable benefit to the Association if allowed to rejoin and urge consideration.
