A. Replacement of the Secretary Treasure was discussed. The Board had a special meeting last Friday, 8/31/2018 at 10AM in order to appoint a replacement for Bryant Champagne who resigned 8/26/2018. As his email informed the membership, he recently accepted a position with Munroe's Safety Apparel and is thus in-eligible to remain a voting member since that organization is not currently a member. Guidance for this situation is provided in the Constitution, Article IV, sections 6 and 8.

The Board voted unanimously to approve Tim Ocnaschek's recommendation that Louie Havens be appointed to fill the remaining four years and four month term of the current Secretary/Treasurer position. He is a long time active member and is four months shy of completing a two year term as Fire Director. This position has to be replaced by a person from a Fire discipline. Since this will put him in line to run the Association in two years, the Board wanted this recommendation to be discussed at this general membership meeting. Tim Ocnaschek asked for membership discussion of concurrence to affirm the Board's appointment. There were no membership comments which Tim verbally stated he would take as concurrence.

B. Discussion and possible action to replace the Fire Director Position for the remaining four months of Louie Havens term pending membership concurrence. Again, in concurrence with the Constitution, Article IV, sections 6 and 8, the B Consensus was that this short term appointment

should be to an experienced and dedicated Fire member who was neither planning nor willing to be formally elected to that position in December which might create an unfair advantage to potential nominees. The Board unanimously approved Tim Ocnaschek recommendation that Dale Jackson be appointed to fill the remaining four months of Chief Havens Fire Director Position. Tim Ocnaschek asked for membership discussion of concurrence to affirm the Board's appointment. There were no membership comments which Tim verbally stated he would take as concurrence.

- C. Action regarding the replacement of the membership committee chair was discussed. Chief Champagne's resignation vacated this position. In accordance with the Constitution, Article VII, section 1 Tim Ocnaschek discussed with the Board his intention to appoint Brian Markland (Lucite) to the position of Membership Committee Chair. Over the last six to eight months, Bryant has asked for someone to take over several times. Brian has been an active member and is in the process of recruiting another member agency and is willing. Tim Ocnaschek asked for membership discussion of concurrence to affirm the Board's appointment. There were no membership comments which Tim verbally stated he would take as concurrence.
- D. Action regarding a bereavement request from Federal Prison (BOP) was discussed. Under SOG 100-7, the Association received this eligible request and is authorized to expend up to \$1000 for support of this family. The Board recommended to membership the request be approved and a \$1000 donation be made to the family.
