OLD BUSINESS:

- a) The outreach meeting was conducted on June 3, 2019, at 5:30PM, Courtyard Café, Groves TX by Charlie Kosh. The meeting was attended by approximately 18 members of the CAP. The presentation about the SNCA was well received by those in attendance.
- b) Southeast Texas Plant Managers Forum Presentation on SNCA to the plant managers forum, Charlie Kosh, Louie Havens, and Tommy Wells to present. Thursday June 27,

NEW BUSINESS:

a) From Vice-President Louie Havens:

Recently Valero has made available a 16' trailer with 500' of 7.5" fire hose to the SNCA as a donation. Tommy Wells and I were contacted by Valero Fire Chief, Bruce King and Joe Tumbleson originally to try and facilitate the donation to the SNCA. Tommy has offered to store and maintain the hose and make it available to our region as a SNCA asset. In an attempt to relieve themselves from liability for the hose's future use or misuse, they attempted to donate it to through the TFS Helping Hands Program. This was determined not to be possible, due to the fact we (the SNCA) are not a Volunteer Fire Department. I requested to check if our 501(c)(4) status would make a difference in our program eligibility. I expect a response in the next few days.

Charlie and I spoke about this and he, Tommy, and I all agree this is an asset we think we need to keep in the area. For all you non-fire types this is really big hose. Much larger than what is commonly carried on fire engines and would be very useful for large tank fires and other fires where very large quantities of water are required. However, this is very special application asset. Adapters and large flow water/pump systems are required. In other words, not an everyday use item, but when you need it, you need it!

Charlie would like the Board to discuss this issue and see if we could come up with a solution that would be satisfactory to all parties.

A couple of possibilities are:

- 1. Donate to Forestry Service's Helping Hands Program and they donate to a volunteer FD
- 2. Valero donate the hose to a local VFD or any Combination FD (if they qualify) and then Energy Transfer store, test, maintain, and provide the hose for use on their behalf.
- 3. Valero sell the trailer and hose to Energy Transfer for a nominal price, say \$2.00 thus essentially transferring liability with the sale.

Any thoughts would be graciously received.

- 2) The Change Over to digital is well underway. Everyone needs to know their inventory on their portables (Are they digital), if you need help to determine if they are digital (Kay Electronic/BEARCOM or the Beaumont Radio Shop can help you determine that). The software for the system should be updated by the end of July. The 1st Quarter of next Year is the scheduled time to switch to digital and you will be notified of any expected

outages (Outages should last only around 3 to 5 minutes) and it will be coordinated with Agencies.
