Chief Smith is a candidate for the 4th Vice President of the State Firemen's and Fire Marshall's Association, and reported on House Bill 96 which exempts volunteer fire departments from taxes on real and personal property. Chief Smith urged all fire departments to encourage their Senators and Representatives to support HB-96. Chief Smith reported on other legislation which will, or has been, submitted in the legislature and encourages all to contact their representatives.

Jake Angello with Channel 12 TV reported that he will make the tape film and make copies for SNCA members. The film should be completed by mid-May. Motion was made by Chief Shelton and seconded by Chief Hebert to authorize the Communications Committee to make the film. Vote was unanimous in favor.

Chief Blanchard gave a report from the Inventory Committee.


Jack Dorgan discussed the possibilities of changing the meeting time to night meetings. A discussion was held.

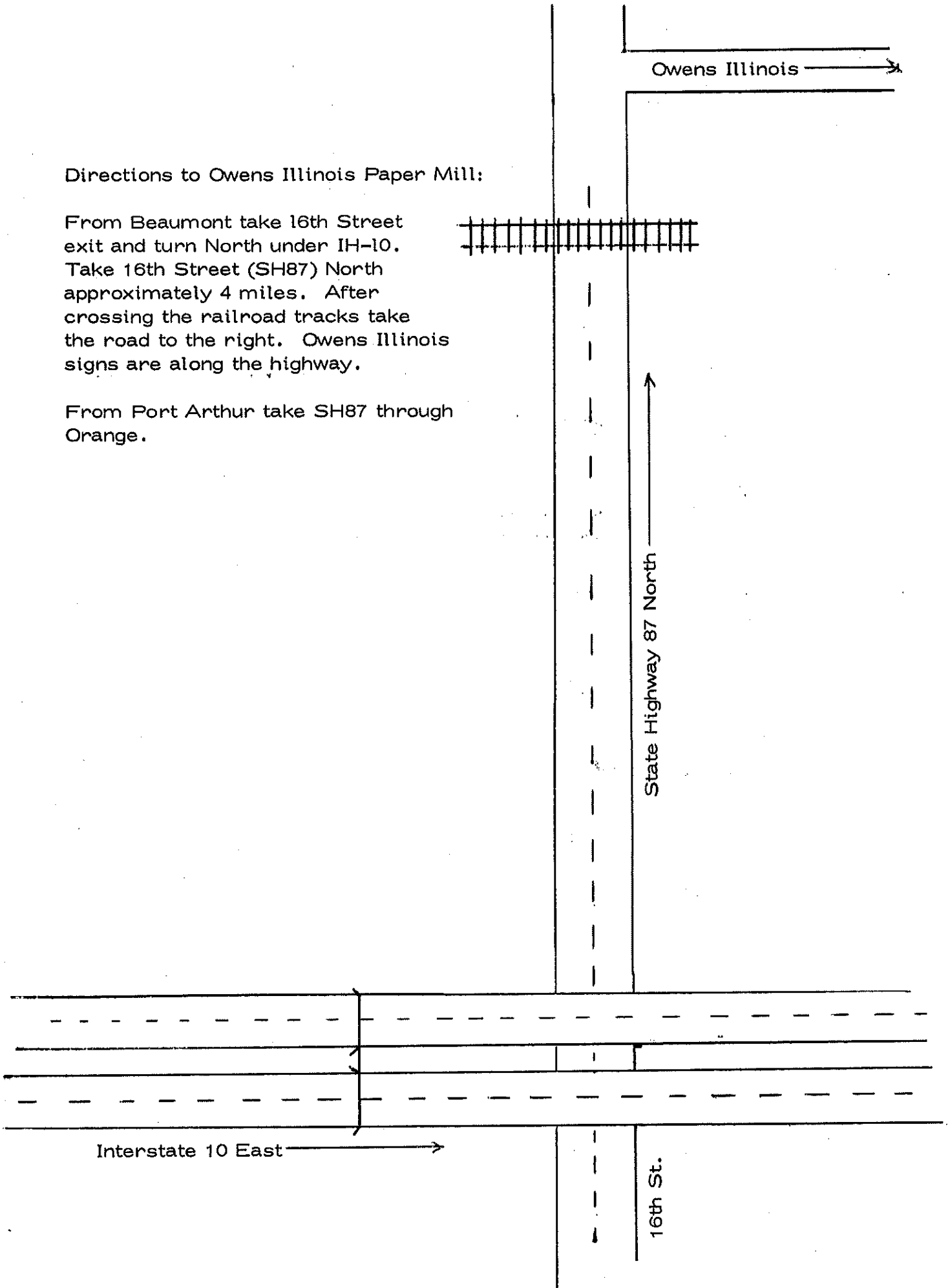




